

English

Over the next half term we will be looking at a range of different writing styles including poetry, writing for information and writing to persuade.

We have guided reading lessons 3 times a week and separate spelling and handwriting lessons. These will be complimented with regular grammar lessons

Maths

In maths we will be building upon our knowledge of number by exploring multiplication, division and the calculation of perimeter and area.

We will do weekly fluency and problem solving lessons, practising our mental maths skills.

Art /DT

In art we will be learning with Miss Molloy about Michelle Reader, an artist who makes fascinating sculptures out of household waste and found objects.

Computing

We use Purple Mash for our computing curriculum and this half term we shall be looking at, exploring and practising coding.

Science

Our Science topic this half term will be looking at forces, gravity and friction. We will be conducting experiments and investigations in order to supplement our scientific knowledge and curiosity.

PE

We are taught PE by Jess on Wednesday afternoons and will be concentrating on our games skills then. On a Tuesday we will be exploring physical literacy and wall games with Mr Enstone.

PSHE

Geography / History

In History we will be delving into the subject of crime and punishment from Anglo Saxon times to modern day. We shall consider how crimes and attitudes to crime and punishment have changed over time.

In Geography, we shall continue expanding on our knowledge of continents, European countries and capital cities.

RE

The question we will look at in our RE lessons this half term is "Why do Christians believe that Jesus was the Messiah?" We shall explore Christians views and evidence from the Bible.

MFL

We will be learning French this year with Mr Enstone and have the opportunity to speak, read and write in French.
