Dear Parents/Carers

Happy New Year! I hope that you had a wonderful Christmas break and are ready for another fun half term.

This half term, the children in Class 1 will be learning about 'Pirates'. We will start off this topic by thinking about where in the world we are, the countries that make up the UK and the seas around the British Isles. We will then move onto famous pirates from the past, life at sea and looking at navigation. Our science work will involve Bernie, our class puppet, learning to become a pirate ensuring that he understands what materials he will need on his boat, how to check treasure to ensure that it is real and how to dress in an appropriate way. Please continue to listen to your child read as often as you can (at least four times a week) and record this in your child's reading diary. Please continue to practise the sounds in your child's phonics folders as often as you are able to.
