English

We will be using the story 'The Owl who was Afraid of the Dark' to start our English off this half term and will be writing nonfiction reports about Barn Owls as well as writing our own chapter of the book. We will also be looking at the book 'Flood' which is a wordless picture book where the children will be adding their own words. We will continue with discrete grammar lessons, spelling 3 times a week and guided reading too.
