

English

This half term, we will be continuing to focus on improving our writing and building on the length of our writing. We will learn writing techniques like fronted adverbials, and formal and informal language, as well as develop our paragraph writing using headings and sub-headings. We will be using these skills, along with other writing techniques to produce different writing styles including a non-chronological report which will be inspired by our class reader. We have Guided Reading 3 times a week, as well as regular spelling and handwriting practice.

Maths

In maths, we will be learning about multiplication and division, fractions, time and money. In lessons, we will deepen our understanding through problem solving. Within Maths, we will also be practising our mental maths skills and times tables.

Art

In Art, we will be learning about mosaics and block painting, whilst looking at the work produced by different artists for inspiration.

History

We are continuing to study the Romans in History. We will look at how the Roman Empire was formed, examine their reasons for invading Britain, discover the life of a Roman soldier and explore how they developed British cities and roads.



Music

We will be focusing on adapting and transporting motifs developing our singing. The theme for this topic will be based on the Romans to match our work in History.

MFL

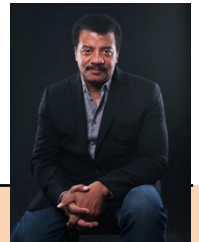


In French we will be studying the topic 'Family and Friends'. This will include introducing family members and pets, as well as identifying areas of their home.
