We will start off this half term by looking at imaginary characters and imaginary worlds linking in with our topic of superheroes.

We will end the half term with some non-fiction writing to make fact files about real life superheroes following a beautiful book about superheroes that help us every day.

Please remember to hear your child read as often as possible, at least **4 times a week** and to **record this in their reading diary**. Don't forget to have a look at for new sounds/words in your child's phonics folders.

Maths

Children in Reception will be counting, adding on and subtracting using much larger numbers. They will be learning about weight, 3D shapes, collecting data, money and telling the time.

Year 1 children will be furthering their knowledge of addition and subtraction. They will also be using money to calculate and problem solve. The children will be learning about measuring length and capacity while collecting data.

PHSE: Health and wellbeing- Who keeps us safe?

Science

In science lessons we will be looking at keeping our bodies healthy. We will learn about germs, where they come from and how we can avoid getting poorly by washing our hands well. We will complete some experiments to look more closely at germs. In our PHSE lessons, we will also look at a healthy diet thinking about the vitamins and minerals in foods and what they do for our bodies. We will think about what a diet of too much sugar and fat does to our bodies.

RE

In Religious Education we will be looking at 'Salvation' through the Easter story. The children will learn about the final weeks of Jesus' life and his resurrection on Easter Sunday. We will be asking 'Why does Easter matter to Christians?'

Computing/ ICT

We will be using the iPads to find out information and play games to further our learning. The children in Y1 will be learning about giving instructions to online characters to make them move in specific ways. In YrR, the children will use Beebots (programmable toys) and learning how to make them move in the right direction!

Curriculum

Our curriculum lessons are all about 'Real Life Superheroes'. We will start off thinking about fantasy superheroes and move on to learning about real life people who help us e.g. police, nurses etc. We will **hopefully** have visits from some of these people as part of our learning unless they have been called out to deal with emergencies. We will learn about Florence Nightingale and her work to look after soldiers and combat germs. We will compare her life to that of Mary Seacole. The children will look at aerial maps of our local area to look for farmers' land, police/fire stations, hospitals and other points of interest.

Phonics with handwriting is taught daily from Monday to Thursday 9.00am until 9.30am.

PE

On Fridays, the children will be completing gymnastic lessons. They will look at rolling, shapes and balances to create simple movement patterns.

On Wednesdays, our sports coach will be teaching the children games. He will look at a variety of different skills and how to work/play as a team.

Art/Design

We will be making lots of crafts to go with our topic of superheroes.

Music

In music we will be looking at pitch and tempo. The theme of our work will be superheroes!
