

English

Over this half term, we will be focusing on improving our writing. We will develop our writing technique through creative effective descriptive sentences through the use of adjectives, adverbs, expanded noun phrases, similes and alliteration. We will be using these skills to produce a diary entry which will be inspired by our class reader for the term. We have Guided Reading 3 times a week, as well as regular spelling and handwriting practice.

Maths

In maths, we will be learning about place value and what each digit represents. After this will be moving onto addition and subtraction. In lessons, we will deepen our understanding of problem solving. We will also be practising our mental maths skills and times tables.

Art

In Art, we will be learning about colours and brush work whilst looking at the artwork produced by Monet.

History

This term's topic in History is 'The Great Fire of London'. We will compare London back then to today, learn about jobs in 1666 and discover how the fire started and its impact on people and the city.



Music

We will be developing an understanding of pitch and musical notation. The theme for this topic will be 'Musical Me'.
