

## English

We will do weekly fluency and problem solving lessons, practising our mental maths skills daily including times tables.

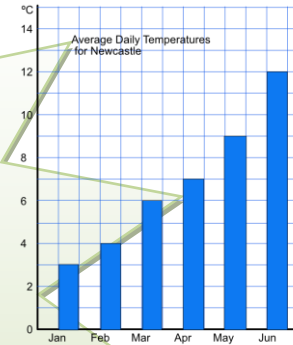
## Art /DT
