

English

Over the next half term we will be writing in both fiction and non-fiction, linked to the text 'Turtle Moon.' The non-fiction techniques will include persuasive writing and explanation writing.

We have guided reading lessons 3 times a week and separate spelling and lessons. These will be complimented with regular grammar lessons

Maths

In maths we will be looking at measurement and statistics. This will include converting units of measurement and interpreting charts and timetables.

We will do weekly fluency and problem solving lessons, practising our mental maths skills daily including times tables.

In art, Miss Molloy will be helping us look at painting, colour and perspective. This will be through the lens of the artist, Cezanne.

Computing

We use Purple Mash for our computing curriculum and we will be exploring hardware and software.

We use the iPads in our computing sessions.



Science

We will be using experiments to support our learning.
